This course is offered in **Health** Track in **semester one**. The aim of this **pre-Intermediate** course **(A2)** is to build on the four language areas and develop students' listening and reading comprehension, spoken and written production, common communication strategies, and grammar. Students will be able to identify the main points of simple listening and reading texts, locate key vocabulary, initiate and interact in simple social exchanges, provide brief descriptions and explanations, and construct connected text on familiar topics. The English for Specific Purposes component of the course focuses on learning English skills and vocabulary in medical contexts.

- Follow, identify and extract information in simple listening and reading passages on familiar topics.

- 5. Express opinion, simple descriptions, reasons and explanations on familiar topics.

- 8. Construct legible sentences and paragraphs conveying clear ideas demonstrating some grammatical and orthographical control.
- 9. Construct texts describing experiences and offering personal opinion.
